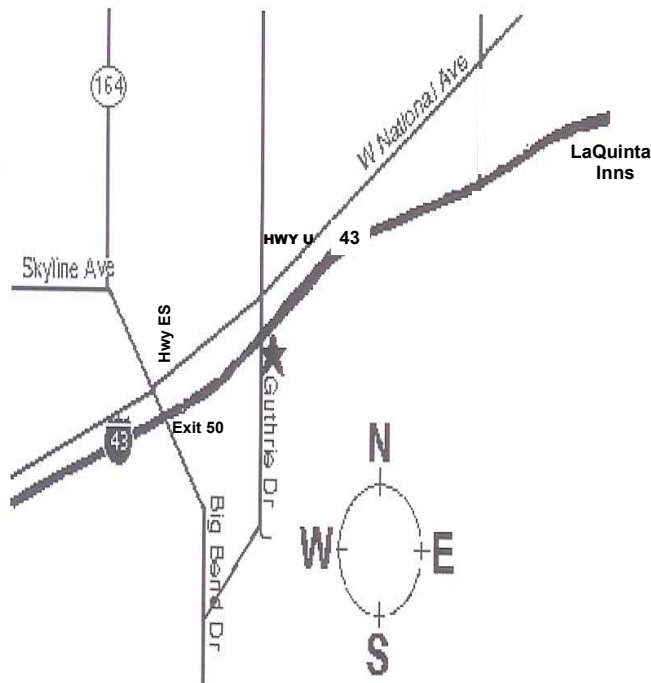
From I94 (North or South), to 894 West toward Madison, take I43 toward Beloit

From the East: Take I-43 south from Milwaukee. Turn right at Exit # 50 - Hwy 164 (Big Bend Road). Turn right (north) on Hwy 164. Go approximately 1/8 mile to National Avenue (Hwy ES) and turn right at the lights (MacDonald's). Take National Avenue (ES) east just over 1 mile. Turn right on Guthrie Drive (Hwy U) and go 1/8 mile, club is on the left.

From the West: Take I-43 north from Beloit. Turn left at Exit 50 - Hwy 164 (Big Bend Road). Go approximately 1/8 mile to National Avenue (Hwy ES) and turn right at the lights (MacDonald's). Take National Avenue (ES) east just over 1 mile. Turn right on Guthrie Drive (Hwy U) and go 1/8 mile, club is on the left.

From the North: Take Hwy 164 south from Waukesha to National Avenue (Hwy ES). Turn left at the lights (gas station) and go east just over 1 mile. Turn right on Guthrie Drive (Hwy U), go 1/8 mile, club is on the left.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

- DOGS NEED TO BE PRESENT ONLY for scheduled judging and will be released if not needed for further judging. Dogs must be ready for judging. Neither the Clubs nor Show Secretaries will be responsible or obligated to furnish any service for notifying the exhibitors or their agents of class being judged. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates.

- JUDGES NEED NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring.

- THE CLUB AND ITS SHOW SECRETARY ASSUME NO RESPONSIBILITY for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This club and its Show Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or owner's agent entering a dog twice or in a class for which the dog is ineligible to compete.

- ENTRY FEES WILL NOT BE REFUNDED in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a veterinarian or a judge; or barred from competition due to their violation of any rules or regulations set forth by the show-giving clubs. (Exception: obedience or rally / bitches in season - request for refund (excluding recording and event fees) must be accompanied by a signed letter from veterinarian so stating.) ADDITIONALLY—No fees will be refunded if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the Club or Show Secretary.

- NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Entries will not be accepted without fees or signatures. Changes, additions, or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or by telegram prior to close of entries. Entries received by telephone are not acceptable. **Errors on Entry Blanks**—Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Conformation — A request for a move up must be submitted to the show secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each class.

Obedience or Rally — No Move Ups/ Transfers Accepted After Closing

- A recording fee of 50 cents and event fee \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. This recording fee is to be collected by the show-giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only (AKC Rule, Chapter 15, Section 2).

- NO SMOKING is allowed in the GSDCW Clubhouse.
- **ALL DOGS TO BE EXERCISED IN DESIGNATED AREAS ONLY.**
- ALL video taping during the show requires permission from the show-giving club.
- ALL prizes must be claimed the day of the show--none will be mailed.
- **NO SPACE PROVIDED FOR UNENTERED DOGS.**

- OWNERS AND/OR THEIR AGENTS are personally responsible to area hotels for any damage caused by their negligence. Following rules shall be followed by all exhibitors:

HOTEL:

- 1) Dogs must be crated when owner is out of room. No exceptions.
- 2) Dogs must be kept on leash at all times while on HOTEL and SHOW grounds.
